St. Patrick's S.N.S. Assembly / Dismissal of pupils

- School opens each morning at 8:30am to allow children attend the breakfast club.
- School officially starts at 9:00am.
- Children are allowed to pass the school gate at 8:30am only if they are going to breakfast club, which is supervised at this time. The care taker makes sure that pupils do not pass the school gate before 8:30am
- If children are not going to breakfast club they are not allowed on the school yard until 8.40am when supervision of the yard starts.
- The yard is supervised by one teacher and one SNA every morning. Teachers carry out this supervision on a rota basis as part of The Croke Park agreement.
- Children arriving after 8:40am and before 9:00am proceed to the big yard where they will be collected by their classroom teacher at 9:00am.
- 6th class children proceed to their yard when the bell sounds at 9:00am
- Children arriving later than 9:00am enter the school through the main school door.
- In inclement weather, the children are permitted to enter the school from 8:40a.m., where they will be supervised in the hall by a teacher and an SNA.
- At 2:40p.m., each classroom teacher dismisses his/her pupils and observes their departure off the school premises/grounds via the main gate.
- Children collecting younger brothers or sisters from the junior school collect them from an agreed point.
- Any children attending the after-school clubs such as Barnardos or Homework club are excluded from the aforementioned. Those children will be dismissed in the same manner by the teacher or person in charge.
